(Who are you (sing)?) Sut wyt ti? (How are you?) / Sut wyt ti'n teimlo? (How do you feel? / How are you feeling?) » Dw i'n teimlo'n hapus / drist. (I feel happy / sad.) Beth wyt ti'n wisgo? (What are you wearing?) Beth wyt ti'n wneud? (What are you doing?) Wyt ti'n hoffi ...? (Do you like ...?) • Pupils could draw a story board and / or a story map to help them learn the story which they could perform. They could also adapt the story to create a new one. • They could create a piece of artwork to depict the story and then evaluate each other's work.
